

## Yonkers farmers market moves to new site



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YONKERS - A downtown Yonkers farmers market has moved to a new site with an expanded number of vendors.

Groundwork Hudson Valley's Get Fresh Yonkers farmers' market will operate at the Philipse Manor Hall State Historic Site, 29 Warburton Ave.

The weekly market will run every Friday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. until Oct. 27.

The market's three new vendors are Red Hibiscus Bakery, General Cochran Farm and Acevedo Farm.

Red Hibiscus Bakery incorporates New York-grown fruits and spices into its Caribbean baked goods, specializing in vegan, gluten-free and sugar-free desserts.

General Cochran Farm raises hormone- and antibiotic-free meats, dairy and eggs in Wassaic, New York.

Acevedo Farm grows vegetables in Goshen, New York. While the farm is not certified organic, its operator Ernesto Acevedo does not believe in using pesticides.

The market will continue to feature locally grown produce and hydroponic vegetables from Groundwork's citizen farmers and from the nearby Science Barge.
